When using bleach, a 5% solution (50,000 ppm) is acceptable.
	Follow the above with a clean water rinse and dry with a soft cloth or towel. For heavy or ingrained soiling follow the cleaning steps as detailed above, then scrub the affected area using a soft brush and warm soapy water, followed by a clean water rinse and dry.

Do not machine wash or dry clean vinyl fabric.</li> <li>Do not use felt tip or ball point pen to mark as this will cause permanent staining.</li> <li>Remove indigo dye from denim and canvas garments immediately as they will produce permanent staining if not dealt with promptly.</li> </ul>
	Using cleaning products contrary to these instructions may compromise the integrity of the fabric. Unsuitable cleaning products will remove the lacquer layer which protects the vinyl fabric and result in hardening and/or cracking of the fabric.
Colour Matching:	Slight variations in shade may occur within normal commercial tolerance. Sample cuttings from the current stock shades can be

obtained on request.
